

PARTICIPANT FUNDRAISING AGREEMENT

Thank you for signing up to take part in the **Brighton Marathon 2025** on Sunday 6th April 2025 in aid of Prostate Cancer Research. We are so grateful for your support and wish you the best of luck in your fundraising, training and the race itself.

It is our principle objective, from your participation in this event, to raise funds for our general purposes. We acknowledge that you have paid a non-refundable registration fee of £24 (including VAT) for your place and have agreed to a fundraising target of no less than £500.

I agree that I

1. Will use my best endeavours to **raise no less than £500 in aid of Prostate Cancer Research** in order to participate in the Brighton Marathon 2024.
2. Consent to be contacted by the Prostate Cancer Research Events team throughout the duration of participation in this challenge in order to receive fundraising updates, milestone reminders and other essential communications via email and telephone.

1. DONATIONS

- 1.1 Will obtain and transfer to Prostate Cancer Research all sums received from sponsors or offline fundraising activities, no later than 28 days after receipt.
- 1.2 Will endeavour to ensure that all cheques which value £20 or more are made payable to Prostate Cancer Research direct.
- 1.3 Will endeavour to ensure that all received cash donations over £20 are passed on to Prostate Cancer Research with immediate effect.
- 1.4 Will explain to donors the information set out above.
- 1.5 Will never pursue donations persistently, intrude unreasonably on a person's privacy or place undue pressure on someone to give money or other property.
- 1.6 Will never pursue a potential donation if a person clearly indicates by word or gesture, that they do not wish to continue, and if there are reasonable grounds for believing that the person is in vulnerable circumstance which means they are unable to make an informed decision.

2. EVENTS

- 2.1 Will not collect funds on private property (including shops, pubs etc) without obtaining permission from the owner.
- 2.2 Will not conduct any raffle or lottery (outside of a single contained event) without first contacting Prostate Cancer Research, as these are subject to licenses and permits, and will follow all regulatory requirements for doing so.
- 2.3 Acknowledge that Prostate Cancer Research cannot take responsibility for any losses made through a fundraising activity or liability arising from the event.
- 2.4 Will contact Prostate Cancer Research no later than 28 days prior to putting on any public event or collection to confirm funds raised.

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3. BRANDS & STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOUR

- 3.1 Will not do anything to bring the name of Prostate Cancer Research into disrepute.
- 3.2 Will be mindful of any social media or other public announcements associated with Prostate Cancer Research, including ensuring that no illegal or unethical activity is posted on any medium.
- 3.3 Will show Prostate Cancer Research any material bearing the charity's name or logo, or that discusses the work of the organisation prior to printing and distribution, and will ensure that all materials include the text: *Prostate Cancer Research is a registered charity in England and Wales no 1156027.*

4. WITHDRAWAL

- 4.1 Will inform Prostate Cancer Research at the earliest possible opportunity if I must withdraw from the Brighton Marathon 2025.
- 4.2 Acknowledge that if I were to withdraw from the event that Prostate Cancer Research would not be able to return donations which have been received in good faith, except in exceptional circumstances.
- 4.3 Understand that Prostate Cancer Research may terminate my rights to fundraise at any time.

4.4 PAYING FUNDRAISING IN

- 4.5 **Cash** - We recommend depositing cash donations in your own bank account and making a bank transfer to us directly.
Please do let us know in advance so we can look out for your donation on our bank statement.
